## PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY <u>BEFORE</u> FITTING THE KIT. If you have a problem, however small, call our Technical Department.

- 1 Push in spring clip and remove the plug on the Mass Air Sensor (MAS), (attached to the air box)
- 2 Press the spring clip and release the clip from the black sensor on the side of the air box. Lift out spring clip and pull out black sensor.
- Remove the two 'O' rings holding down the air box. Release the heavy duty clamp on the inlet hose using large vice grips, **take care**.
- 4 Remove the **MAS** from the intake hose and release the sensor cable from the air box lid. Remove the air box lid and air box base.
- 5 Remove the **MAS** from the air box.
- Fit the new intake flange to the **MAS** using the three short screws, washers and nuts supplied, **Drawing A.** Fit the bracket to **MAS** using the long screw.
- 7 Fit the MAS back into the intake hose, don't fit the clamp yet.
- Fit the bracket to the top stud on the suspension turret, using the original nut. Attach the other end of the bracket to the **MAS** using the long screw **Drawing B**.
- **9** The clamp can now be fitted on the intake hose.
- Fit the filter to the new flange, positioning the K&N logo straight. **Don't overtighten clip.**Push the black sensor into the small hole in the filter base and replace the spring clip. **Drawing C & D.**
- 11 Cold air intake system.
- 11.1 Raise the offside of the car, taking all the necessary safety precautions.
- **11.2 Drawing E.** Reposition horn to provide clearance for flexi hose.
- **11.3** Carefully expand the hose to approx. 16" / 40cm. Attach the top section of hose to the cable support using a long plastic tie. Finish hose 4" / 10cm from the filter, **NO NEARER.**
- 11.4 Feed the hose downwards and position as Drawing C,E & F.
- 12 Tuning.
  - **CAT. Cars.** No adjustments are required.

An increase in fuel may be required if further engine modifications are to be carried out.

13 Filter maintenance.

Under normal conditions clean and re oil the filter at approx. 40,000 miles / 65,000 Km. **Use only K&N Cleaner** and oil and follow the instructions carefully.

K&N Filters are pre oiled ready to fit.

Cooler air, being denser, will show positive improvements in power over filter systems that draw hot air from the engine bay.


# IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROUND ENTRY CLAMP ON AIR FILTERS


Gently tighten the hose clip to the point where the filter will just rotate on the pipe or intake flange Reposition the K&N logo straight, then give the clip two turns i.e. 360, no more.


#### **FITTING YOUR OWN 57i KIT**

If not, it is essential that the person fitting the kit (e.g. mechanic) carefully follows these particular instructions even if he has fitted K&N kits before. This will save you both time and money. Kits incorrectly fitted may show a loss in performance e.g. the positioning of the essential cold air hose, (flexi expandable and rubber hoses are used).

A final check under the bonnet, by yourself, with the instructions, would seem sensible.








FILTER REAR VIEW
